Our latest blend features coffees processed in both the washed and natural styles, from some of our strongest producer partnerships. Expect a kick of ripe fruit balanced by a sugary sweetness. No Boundaries tastes great and is easy to brew on all brewing methods.</p> <p>Main Text:</p> <p>As the seasons change, we welcome fresh coffees into our blends to ensure that what’s in your cup is as vibrant and flavourful as the day it left port. This seasonal emphasis is balanced by our strict sourcing and roasting standards which ensure that each blend remains true to form and flavour profile, even as components come and go.</p> <p>This winter’s blend is a mix of two coffees, processed in two different styles – one washed and one natural. The washed component comes from a new partnership with the El Bombo womens group, comprised</p>		

	<p>of around 60 female coffee producers in the department of Huila, in south central Colombia. The group was formed after El Bombo Association conducted extensive research into what would most help improve livelihoods for their members, and determined that gender equity and access to alternative income sources in non-harvest periods were on the top of the list. While the relationship between Caravan and ASOBOMBO is relatively new, we are excited about our shared values and what possibilities the future holds.</p> <p>The natural component comes from the Bulambuli washing station in the Mt Elgon region of Uganda, where coffee is grown up to 2300 meters above sea level – some of the highest elevations in the world. The washing station was only constructed in 2021 with support from our import partners, Nordic Approach, who are industry leaders in exquisite quality coffees from East Africa. The farmers who sell cherries to Bulambuli are paid a fair and transparent price and are able to access additional premiums through the sale of natural process coffees like this one.</p>
BREW GUIDE:	<p>We select and roast each component of our signature filter blend for sweetness and balance, to shine in your cup with or without milk. Our latest blend has a big pop of acidity while remaining easy to brew and drink. Try starting with our go-to recipe of 60g per litre of fresh, filtered water and adjust to taste.
