Keyline tips

Graphic Design are inserted into Keyline Templates from which Tetra Pak prints customer order.

The Keyline is built in layers, layers can be turned on and off (by clicking the Eye-icon in the Layers view). We recommend that you turn off, —or delete, layers that are not applicable for your work but that you always keep the "Keyline" and "Mask" layers.

It's recommended that you begin working on layers below the "Mask" layer. Since the "Mask" layer function masks off areas that are free from design or not visible on the ready package for your convenience.

There is already an empty "JOB" layer (rename if you like) where you can start, others can be added.

Before starting the design work it's recommended to read about the specification applicable to this package type and the print method it's to be printed in. These specifications and more are available in the Tetra Pak Design Manual. Please contact the local Tetra Pak Market Company for more information on this.
